 - Gardens look amazing!
 - Will need more help mid-August with weeding before back to school
- Bring In/Give Back: Tammy Webber
 - Trying to get ink cartridges straightened out
 - We think it's only name brand ones that we get paid for
- Cafeteria: Jen Hopkins
 - Need to push for more volunteers especially with younger students
- Carnival:
 - Fun to see kids' excitement last year was a HUGE turnout
 - Event broken into 3 parts: Auction, Food, Outside
 - Need more donations for Silent Auction
 - Letters distributed for people to solicit donations
 - Also need sponsors for booths
- Hospitality: Morgan Polan
 - Art Show/Ice Cream Social
 - PTA paid for ice cream
 - Toppings were donated
 - Lots of volunteers
- Yearbook: Danielle Spigler
 - Yearbooks are in and will be counted next week
 - Flyer will come home regarding extra yearbooks
 - Presale was 3 ½ months long
 - Price goes up to \$25 for limited quantities
 - Sold before homeroom, cash or check
 - Zoom pages/year in review was included for free
- Family Fun: Danielle Spigler for Heather Holdaway
 - Chuck E Cheese Night coming
 - Information will be sent home
- Spiritwear: Danielle Spigler for Kim Ewers
 - Kim needs to step down
 - Need a new chairperson
- o Carnival: Danielle Spigler for Chrissy Sandifer
 - The current committee recommends not having carnival next year
 - Lack of volunteers
 - o Steep decline in volunteers over the past three years
 - HUGE undertaking
 - No one is bidding on silent auction; not getting value
 - Not enough donations collected for auction
 - We had to rent booths-only had one corporate sponsor
 - Very low/significant return on the efforts made
 - \$2400 less than budgeted
 - Parts of the building and property that were not treated with respect
 - o Kona Ice trash everywhere on playground equipment
 - o Art Room was not cleaned up after last shift
 - Rain/weather issues
 - Hallways locked for cleaning
 - Custodians
 - Need to do normal duty and help us
 - Mrs. Jankowiak recommends them coming for the day after to take care of duties and extra duties; possibly making a line item for custodians, or include in Carnival budget
 - Discussion of possible alternative fundraisers

- Bull Roast, Bingo, Dance, etc
- New Business
 - o Sarah Penney: Painted Rock landscape display
 - Based no the book Only You
 - Already received commitment of \$500 donation from Sarah Camarote
 - Need 600 rocks for students and 100 for staff plus other supplies
 - New board could work with staff
 - Willing to do a formal report or presentation
 - Next year:
 - Look into ways of getting supplies; prep site for rocks
 - Work with art teacher or by class
 - Maybe start with 5th grade? Maybe only 2017-2018 students at PMES?

 - Election Nominees
 - President: none
 - Vice President: Sarah Penney

 - President called for nominations from the floor. None were presented. Nominations were then closed.
 - Motion to proceed with a voice vote. Unanimously voted to continue with a voice vote for entire slate.
 - o Vote was held. Unanimously voted to elect three officers. Election was closed.
 - o Regarding President Vacancy per Bruce Butz
 - With no president, our corporation status could be voided
 - Option 1: Vice President moves to President
 - Option 2: Current President stays on as ACTING president until an election is held
 - Potential candidates are encouraged to shadow for one year
 - Election must take place at a general membership meeting TBA
 - All nominees must be current members of the PTA
 - Members may join at any time, including at this meeting
 - At least one person has expressed interest in shadowing for some time.
 - Nominations will be accepted up until an election can be held.
 - o It would be strongly encouraged for anyone interested to be an active member of the board to gain insight and understanding as to what is involved in holding this position.
