Please start talking with your children now about what they would like to do in the talent show. Participation in the Talent Show is not mandatory but encouraged. This is a great experience and opportunity for the children!

#### **NEW REGISTRATION PROCESS THIS YEAR: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!!!**

A registration/audition process will be held in the Prospect Mill Gym on Thursday, February 16<sup>th</sup> immediately after school. You MUST send in the attached permission slip in order for your child to be able to stay after school for registration/auditions. Parent Pickup will promptly at 4:30. You MUST come in via the Gym doors to sign your child out.

## An AUDITION PERMISSION SLIP is required for EACH STUDENT staying for auditions on Feb. 16<sup>th</sup>

ONE completed REGISTRATION FORM is required for each ACT/GROUP. Both should be sent in no later than February 14<sup>th</sup>.

We have a large number of students so we are highly encouraging <u>GROUP ACTS of 3 or more participants</u>, as our goal is to accommodate all students who would like to participate from our very large student body, but solos are accepted. *Students may not be in more than ONE act* with the exception of the fifth graders who can also participate in the fifth grade finale. Costumes are not required but encouraged and must be approved by the committee at registration.

### What to bring to registration on February 16th:



- $\Box$  All members of act must be present
- Copy of printed song lyrics & copy of music (CD or on an iPod or phone) (you may be asked to consider another song if too many children are choosing the same song so be creative and avoid the most popular if you can)
- □ A list of all equipment/props you plan on using (which need to be managed quickly & easily by the students participating in the act)
- $\square$  A small sample of performance act does NOT need to be fully complete at this time
- □ Costumes (photo ok)

#### Acts must not exceed 2 minutes

No more than 40 Acts will be accepted to control the length of the show.

Some special jobs will be available for fifth grade students. Only fifth graders who do NOT wish to participate in an act can volunteer to help out with back stage crew or to EMCEE the show. All fifth graders, even if in an individual act or who volunteer for one of the helper positions can participate in our fifth grade finale as well.
