There is one changed on the 4th quarter report cards. This year they are not going to make the report cards go live until the 17th of June (K-12). If we have any parents that cannot get it please let us know and we can help you get it.

There are a lot of programs available this summer for students. This year with Covid there are additional funds. There is also summer tutoring. We sent out 85 letters to families that they can continue with Reading interventions. We looked at the number of kids and where they are currently preforming as we have been testing kids. This is great because we can still deliver this to children so they don't fall behind. There are three different things going on in our county. Summer School (that parents can opt into), tutoring, interventions for just Reading and not Math. It is twice a week (Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday. We are looking at specific kids based on testing to maintain. We are looking at the last week in June and we would not meet with kids July 4th. We worked on a summer schedule which is 4 days a week. However, the tutoring can happen at any time and any area (Math, Reading, and Writing). The tutor supports whatever the child needs.

We are very excited for the 5th grade ceremony. We still are sticking to two guests and we do still need to wear masks even though it's outside. We just need to manage everyone's comfort level and maintain

Lisa Rice asked what is the VOE Summit? Mrs. Jankowiak said that it stands for Voice of Equity. In our county there has been a big push to county for this. I looked at level of service, gender, race, ethnicity, religions, and languages. Part of the elementary level is that we want to give people voices. We invited 10 kids from our school and chose from 4th grade. It has to have parent permission for kids to go.
